

Milton Keynes Community Boat: Boat Crew roles available

Skipper:

- In overall charge of the boat and safety on the cruise
- Helms / handles the boat
- Requires formal national qualification (Certificate in Community Boat Management) plus e-boat and local boat training

Cabin Host:

- In charge of customer care
- Assists with boat handling
- Requires First Aid Qualification plus e-boat and local boat training

Boat Assistant (optional role on cruises needing an 'extra pair of hands'):

- Assists with boat handling at moorings, locks, at night
- Assists with customer care and catering service
- Requires e-boat and local boat training

What our training team will do for boat crew volunteers:

- Value your help and respect you as an individual
- Provide background knowledge and practical experience
- Provide full training for all roles
- Tailor training to your needs by asking you to complete a Skills Profile and a practical Boat Induction

What we expect from boat crew volunteers:

- To formally register for a role with the MK Community Boat
- To be medically fit for crewing responsibilities
- To commit to complete all training required
- To be a Full or Associate member of the Trust
- To crew regularly on 10 - 30 trips per year (about 10-15 days pa)
