



Walk & Glide Weekend 24/25 September: Arrival Directions

Please check your ticket and follow the instructions and timing for the event option you have chosen from the eight listed below.

Option 1:

Campbell Wharf to Simpson Village return - Glide then Walk, Saturday 24 September 09:00-12:00

Park There is public car parking and street parking within 10 minutes' walk of Electra's mooring at Campbell Wharf, at the end of Silbury Boulevard (NOT Campbell Park or Campbell Park Marina) – check local maps.

Meet Be at Campbell Wharf [What3Words: ///readers.locals.aimlessly](http://What3Words:///readers.locals.aimlessly) promptly at 09:00, in readiness for the 09:15 cruise departure.

Glide along the Grand Union canal past the start of the Bedford & Milton Keynes Waterway, Woolstone and Woughton, and arrive at Simpson Village, disembarking near bridge 92.

Walk Your Parks Trust guide will then lead you back to Campbell Wharf on a walk through the beautiful Ouzel Valley park, following the river Ouzel and looking out for wildlife along the way. Arrive back about 12:00 <https://www.plotaroute.com/route/1694680>

Option 2:

Simpson Village to Waterhall Park return - Glide then Walk, Saturday 24 September 11:00-14:00

Park at the carpark next to The Caldecotte Xperience off Simpson Road, Simpson Village. [What3Words: ///shades.pill.ants](http://What3Words:///shades.pill.ants) Cross the road and take the earth path that leads you onto the canal towpath just south of Grand Union canal bridge 92.

Meet Find Electra on the towpath just south of Grand Union canal bridge 92, promptly at 11:00, in readiness for the 11:15 cruise departure.

Glide along the canal Fenny Stratford Lock and Fenny Stratford, arrive at Waterhall Park and disembark on the towpath near the bridge.

Walk Your guided walk led by the Parks Trust will bring you back off the towpath to let you explore some of the beautiful parklands adjacent to the canal including Waterhall Park and Caldecotte South <https://www.plotaroute.com/route/1694674>, arriving back at about 14:00.

Option 3:

Simpson Village to Waterhall Park return - Walk then Glide, Saturday 24 September 11:30-14:30

Park at the carpark next to The Caldecotte Xperience off Simpson Road, Simpson Village. [What3Words: ///shades.pill.ants](http://What3Words:///shades.pill.ants)

Meet your Parks Trust guide promptly at 11:30 in the carpark.

Walk Your guided walk will take you away from the towpath to explore some of the beautiful parklands adjacent to the canal including Caldecotte South and Waterhall Park. <https://www.plotaroute.com/route/1694674> You'll arrive at Water Eaton Mill in time for a short pause before you board Electra, moored on the canal towpath in readiness for the 13:15 cruise departure.

Glide Your canal cruise will take you through Fenny Stratford, passing through Fenny Stratford Lock, and returning to Bridge 92 about 14:30.

Option 4:

Campbell Wharf to Simpson Village – Walk then Glide, Saturday 24 September 13:30-16:30

Park There is public car parking and street parking within 10 minutes' walk of Electra's mooring at Campbell Wharf, at the end of Silbury Boulevard (NOT Campbell Park or Campbell Park Marina) – check local maps.

Meet your Parks Trust guide at the new bridge at Campbell Wharf overlooking the marina [What3Words: ///slippery.supported.overtone](http://What3Words:///slippery.supported.overtone) promptly at 13:30.

Walk Your guided walk will take you through the beautiful Ouzel Valley park, following the river Ouzel and looking out for wildlife along the way. <https://www.plotaroute.com/route/1694680> You will arrive on the canal towpath in Simpson Village, ready to board Electra, which will be moored on the canal south of bridge 92, ready for the 15:15 cruise back to Campbell Wharf.

Glide Your cruise will take you past Woughton, Woolstone and the start of the Bedford & Milton Keynes Waterway, arriving back at Campbell Wharf around 16:30.



**Option 5:
Campbell Wharf to Linford Wharf return - Glide then Walk, Sunday 25 September 09:00-12:00**

Park There is public car parking and street parking within 10 minutes' walk of Electra's mooring at Campbell Wharf, at the end of Silbury Boulevard (NOT Campbell Park or Campbell Park Marina) – check local maps.

Meet Be at Campbell Wharf [What3Words: /// readers.locals.aimlessly](#) promptly at 09:00 in readiness for the 09:15 cruise departure.

Glide along the canal catching glimpses of the Gyosei Art Trail, past Pennylands, Giffard Park, arriving at Linford Wharf and disembarking on the towpath to take a good look around this site.

Walk On your way back, discover the delights the Canal Broadwalk on a walk with a Parks Trust guide. Look out for sculptures on the Gyosei Art Trail and find out more about the historic brick kilns along the way. Arrive back around 12:00. <https://www.plotaroute.com/route/1984156>

**Option 6:
Linford Wharf to New Bradwell return - Glide then Walk, Sunday 25 September 11:00-14:00**

Park at Great Linford Memorial Hall, Marsh Drive, Great Linford, Milton Keynes MK14 5AX. Walk towards the canal along Marsh Drive, over the canal footbridge, down the steps and under the bridge on the towpath to find Linford Wharf [What3Words:///presuming.central.papers](#)

Meet Electra on the towpath at Linford Wharf promptly at 11:00, ready for the 11:15 cruise departure to New Bradwell.

Glide along the canal past Great Linford Manor Park, under the railway bridge and past the Black Horse pub, through Stanton Low and New Bradwell, stopping just before the V6 aqueduct around 12:30.

Walk Your Parks Trust guide will take you on a scenic return walk through New Bradwell and Stanton Low Park, taking in historical points of interest along the way including Bradwell Windmill and the ruins of St Peters church, returning to Memorial Hall Car Park by 14:00. <https://www.plotaroute.com/route/1984169>

Check what you're bringing

- Bring your ticket and make sure you have these Arrival Directions with you.
- Come dressed for the weather on the day, with sturdy footwear.
- Please note the Galley Bar is card-only; Challenge 25 ID checks are made, so bring photo ID if needed.
- Only guide dogs and assistance dogs are allowed on board.
- No smoking or vaping is permitted on Electra or at any Boarding Point.

**Option 7:
Linford Wharf to New Bradwell return - Walk then Glide, Sunday 25 September 11:30-14:30**

Park at Great Linford Memorial Hall, Marsh Drive, Great Linford, Milton Keynes MK14 5AX.

Meet your Parks Trust guide in the Memorial Hall car park promptly at 11:30.

Walk Enjoy a scenic walk with your Parks Trust guide through Great Linford Manor Park, Stanton Low Park and New Bradwell. They will show you some historical points of interest along the way, including the ruins of St Peters church and the Bradwell Windmill. <https://www.plotaroute.com/route/1984169> Arrive at New Bradwell to board Electra, which will be moored on the canal towpath just south of the V6 aqueduct, ready to board in time for the 13:15 cruise back to Linford Wharf.

Glide Your cruise will take you through New Bradwell and the countryside at Stanton Low, under the beautiful traditional canal bridge 75 and past the Black Horse. You'll arrive back at Linford Wharf at around 14.30.

**Option 8:
Campbell Wharf to Linford Wharf return - Walk then Glide, Sunday 25 September 13:30-16:30**

Park There is public car parking and street parking within 10 minutes' walk of Electra's mooring at Campbell Wharf, at the end of Silbury Boulevard (NOT Campbell Park or Campbell Park Marina) – check local maps.

Meet your Parks Trust guide at the new bridge at Campbell Wharf overlooking the marina [What3Words:///slippery.supported.overtones](#) promptly at 13:30.

Walk On your walk to Linford Wharf with your Parks Trust guide, enjoy the delights of the Canal Broadwalk. Look out for sculptures on the Gyosei art trail and find out more about the historic brick kilns. <https://www.plotaroute.com/route/1984156> You'll arrive on the canal towpath Linford Wharf, ready to board Electra for the 15:15 cruise departure back to Campbell Wharf.

Glide Your cruise will take you past Giffard Park, Pennylands, and Campbell Park, with glimpses of artworks on the art trail, arriving back at Campbell Wharf around 16:30.

Staying safe

Electra's qualified volunteer crew provide safe and enjoyable cruises. Please follow their instructions at all times. Small delays on cruises can sometimes be beyond our control, if the canal is very busy. Cruises are run in line with public health guidance. We sanitise the boat before each cruise, have good ventilation, and use an air filter. The boat has a toilet. Parks Trust Walk Leaders have completed training to keep you safe and have a wealth of knowledge about the area and the parks to share with you on your walk. Please ensure you listen to their instructions and safety briefings.
